1. The above subject was issued by the Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization a permit to reenter the United States, No. *275765* on *12 Nov 1952*. The permit is valid for reentry into the United States until *12 Nov 1953*. The possession by the alien of this permit at the time he desires to travel to the United States will eliminate the necessity of his having a visa to the United States if the permit will be valid as of the date that he arrives at a port of entry in the United States.

2. Extensions of the permit can be granted under the law only for six-month periods. To obtain an extension of the permit for the alien, it will be necessary for him to make an application to the Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization, Washington, D.C. The application may be drawn at the field station. It does not have to be in the following form, but should contain the points indicated therein.

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3. The application must be executed and sworn to before a U. S. Consular Officer prior to its expiration date. There is no exception to this requirement. If the alien is operating under cover which operational security factors would not permit revelation to a Consular Officer of his connections with the government, this office should be consulted.

4. Your field representative should transmit to your office the permit and the application for extension and an international money order in the amount of three dollars drawn on Washington, D.C., or foreign exchange on a bank in the United States, payable to the Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization, Washington, D.C. If preferable to your office, you may purchase a postal money order for three dollars in the United States which will suffice. Cash or check will not be acceptable.

5. The permit, application, and fee of three dollars should be delivered to this office by hand. Upon acquisition of an extension, the permit will be returned to your office by hand for transmittal to your field representative and delivery to the alien.

6. The application must be sworn to before a U. S. Consular Officer prior to its expiration date, or the alien may have serious difficulties in returning to the United States. A permit is a valuable document to an alien. It is prepared on protected paper, and safeguards are taken to prevent falsifications. A receipt should be taken from the alien when it is delivered to him.

7. Action by your field representative should be taken sufficiently in advance, considering the time required for transmittal to and from headquarters, to afford an extension prior to the expiration.
