1. It has come to our attention that further biographic information on subject is necessary before the appropriate office will grant Operational Clearance.

2. Because of the discrepancies in subject's biographic statements, Headquarters is not able to supply the additional information required. Therefore, it is requested that subject be indirectly debriefed on the following:

- a. His dealings with the Germans during World War II.
- b. The details of his daughter's deportation to Siberia by the Russians in 1941.
- c. His contacts with the Bolsheviks while their prisoner during the early 1920's, and the circumstances of his release.

3. Headquarters realizes that such a debriefing of subject will necessitate diplomatic handling. If practicable, subject can be debriefed by while he is in London.

4. Subject received covert security clearance on 3 November 1952.
