~~Stamam~~ There is no possibility here for me to obtain a job; therefore, I believe I will go to Los Angeles, as I ~~stated~~ indicated to you previously. I can probably get a job quicker there than an ordinary laborer, even though it would be a dirty job in some factory. It is very unfortunate that I was released from my job so quickly and that no one is assisting me in finding a new job. Now I must begin my life in America from the beginning again.

Since I do not have much money, I ask you to arrange everything so that we could iron out everything as soon as possible, and so that it would not be necessary for me to go to Washington. It's easier for you to come here, or to send the money through [] []. I beg of you to do this.

I send best wishes to you and my other friends.
