1. Headquarters records indicate, and Contract Personnel Division affirms that Subject was a Contract Agent of this organization from 7 November 1952 until his termination on 1 October 1954. During this period his activities and working conditions were strictly those of a Contract Agent, and could in no way be interpreted as those of an Employee. Therefore, since he was not an employee of the U.S. Government during this period, he is not entitled to pay into the Civil Service Retirement plan.

2. FYI: From November 1952 until December 1953, when his job was abolished as "unnecessary," Subject served as our liaison with a Lithuanian emigre organization in London. Although he no longer performed substantial services for us after that date, he was not formally terminated until 1 October 1954.

3. The legend referred to in paragraph 2 of reference was given to Subject merely to backstop his activities and time with us, and to aid him in finding employment. He was not, and could not be considered a Contract Employee.
