<p>1. Recent intercept coverage on Hans RECHENBERG [] has revealed that Subject is currently working for UPHILL. Results thus far however do not conclusively prove that he is witting of UPHILL sponsorship. (Chief, FE: Details on Hans RECHENBERG and his activities are available in EK files.)</p> <p>2. A copy of the first intercept pertaining to Subject was sent to Headquarters and COS, Germany with reference. Since that time RECHENBERG has established direct contact, probably through the good offices of Dr. Robert SEWATINS, Adolf KUCHMANN's defense attorney and/or Francois GREGOIR (details on these individuals and their relationship with RECHENBERG known to Headquarters and COS). In any case LAUCC calls RECHENBERG in Munich circa 10 May 1962 and they proceed to discuss what appears to be a plan to establish an UPHILL operation against South Vietnam. They believe that a suitable cover would be a man who trades in rice and rubber. LAUCC has contact to one PHAN HUYCO, residing in Paris, 87 Rue Lafayette, a medical doctor, married with 6 children. Apparently the latter plays some part in the LAUCC/RECHENBERG planning.</p> <p>3. Traces are requested on PHAN HUYCO.</p>
