Soviet Personality Reports

REFERENCE: Book Dispatch No. 4232 dated 3 Apr 64

1. The US Desk of the SR Division is currently preparing Soviet Personality Reports on all Soviets permanently stationed in the United States. The task of assembling the necessary data in some cases has become monumental, but as each SPR is completed, it will be forwarded to the field immediately. If Headquarters files contain insufficient information on a Soviet to complete a useful SPR, we will send what we have now, keyed to the SPR, and more later as it comes in. The field, in turn, is requested to submit to Headquarters all additional information as it is acquired. In this way, continuous, up-to-date and meaningful operational planning can be conducted by both Headquarters and the field with the least amount of unnecessary remedial correspondence.

2. The US Desk is concentrating first on the Soviets stationed in New York City. We wish to point out, however, that the order in which the SPR's will be sent to the field will not be indicative of the Soviet's priority position as a target or his degree of recruitability or vulnerability. We would appreciate your comments and suggestions as the project progresses.
