1. References indicate that Headquarters will cable traces on newly arrived PCS Soviets only in cases where a cable reply is requested.

2. As you are aware, we have for some time been regularly receiving cable traces on PCS Soviets to speed up service for [ ] and [ ] as agreed upon with them. While we are under no illusions that [ ] or [ ] would ever use any derogatory information from us as the basis <sup>for</sup> recommending refusal of accreditation to a new Soviet nominee (in many cases we get their request for traces after the Soviet's arrival), we do feel that it is politic to continue to furnish traces, or at least a summary, as quickly as possible, and therefore request that replies to requests for Headquarters traces on newly assigned PCS Soviets continue to be cabled as in the past.
