It has been the practice of   not to request Headquarters traces on newly arriving PCS Soviets, both those to be assigned to the Soviet Permanent Delegation as well as to international organizations, on the basis of   provided visa issuance information, but to await confirmation of arrival through notification from   that a legitimation card has been issued. This practice does not appear to conform with paragraph 4,d of Reference A. It furthermore causes considerable delay in our efforts to stay on top of the Soviet target on a timely basis. Although we are unable to cite exact statistics, it appears that the great majority of Soviets who apply for PCS   visas do arrive although there is often considerable delay in confirming actual arrival, which is caused by delay in receiving legitimation card issuance notices from   as well as by lack of complete target coverage by  .

2. We therefore plan to institute the procedure outlined in Reference A in the near future, i.e., notifying Headquarters by cable of visa issuances and requesting traces  . Although the working of paragraph 4,d of Reference A is applicable to Soviets to be assigned to Embassies and commercial missions abroad, we presume that the intent of the book dispatch would place Soviets assigned to international organizations in the same category.
