AT NIGHT ALKSNIS READ THE SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIAL. YES, FOUR NEPHEWS AND TWO OF FRITISIS' FIRST COUSINS WERE LIVING AND WORKING HONESTLY IN VARIOUS CITIES IN LATVIA AND HAD NOT RECENTLY BEEN AWAY AND HAD NEVER BEEN OUT OF THE COUNTRY. BUT IT WAS SHOWN THAT FRITISIS HAD STILL ANOTHER FIRST COUSIN. HE WAS A DRIVER FOR THE RIGA TAXI FLEET. ALBERT (AKA LAGZDINS), THIS RELATIVE OF FRITISIS, SAID THAT HIS UNCLE, AL'FRED RIEKSTIN'SH, SERVED IN THE HITLER ARMY AND AFTER THE WAR HE DISAPPEARED.

"IF THIS RIEKSTIN'SH SERVED WITH THE GERMANS, THEN THERE SHOULD BE SOMETHING ABOUT HIM IN THE ARCHIVES", SAID ALKSNIS.
