1. The 513th AIG states that a West German customs/border official, who is a contact of their Bremerhaven Station, suggested that Subject may know persons who would be of interest to U. S. intelligence. The U. S. intelligence interest referred to is in legal or illegal border crossings from West Germany to East Germany and/or Berlin for OB purposes and the customs official has done similar spotting for the 513th in the past. It is not clear why Subject might be useful in this connection unless it is because of his current residence and position. In any event, the 513th is aware of Subject's Rote Kapelle role but has no interest in that aspect.
2. Essentially, then, the trace request is for any derogatory information which would argue against the use of Subject as a spotter.
3. For the record, we have warned the 513th that UPHILL may have some sort of contact with Subject. Nevertheless, the Army still is interested in following up the lead.
