On November 30, 1964, DL T-1 furnished a letter in the German language written to Glenn Sparks, Dallas, Texas. DL T-1 advised the letter was signed by Hans-Ulrich Rudel who was a highly decorated Nazi pilot during World War II. The translation of this letter appears below:

"Hans-Ulrich Rudel

Kufstein, Tirol 23.4.64.

"Dear Glenn Sparks,

"In a round-about way your lines of January 1st which you had sent to my sister reached me. I was happy to receive your greeting.

"Above you have my address here, although I am about to make a trip to South America. In a few weeks I shall be back here.

"Unfortunately I am a very busy man and therefore not a very good pen pal; but of course I answer all my mail.

"It will interest you that I cannot obtain a visa for the US; perhaps it would be easier if I were a Communist.

"I wish you the best and send you my best regards,
