1. Reference is made to your request dated 8 August 1951 for a Covert Security Clearance to permit Subject's entry into the United States and his training while in this country in connection with project Boulder.
2. Your office was subsequently advised that because of certain derogatory information the Subject was security disapproved for use as requested.
3. Since issuance of the above disapproval information has been received from appropriate officials in OPC indicating that, in spite of the security considerations in this case, an appropriate clearance should be granted in the face of operational necessity.
4. Accordingly a Covert Security Clearance is granted for the period of Subject's training in the United States with the proviso that, upon entry into the United States, Subject be given a full interview in addition to a technical interrogation, the results of which should both be forwarded to this office for review.
