OPERATIONAL MATTERS AND COMMENTS:

1. Regarding the unidentified woman who phoned and appeared at agent's residence during agent's absence in May 1958 and on 4 May 1958 (see CR #3), agent reported the woman appeared several days before instant contact in response to agent's letter to a Lonely Heart's ad in a local newspaper. Agent discounted anything in his relationship with the dameal which could affect his security or relationship with the AIS.

2. Subject was provided with an NB telephone number which he was instructed to use only in emergency. He was also instructed regarding three RV places and regarding mutual counter-surveillance procedures he and the case officer will employ at RVs. Codes were instituted for scheduling RVs over the telephone.

3. [] offered agent EM 100 to cover expenses he incurred in travel to RV, etc. Agent refused any money at this time (see note). If and when it is decided to pay agent a regular salary, it will be proposed to him that such monies be held by the AIS in an escrow account for him. It will be explained that our primary consideration for this proposal is security and that such monies will be turned over to him at the termination of his relationship with the AIS.

NOTE: Since agent appears to have access to American PX installations via his contacts at the United States Consulate and other friends, [] provided agent with shaving accessories which agent earlier mentioned he needed.

4. Agent said he will be busy during the next two weeks in moving from his current location for permanent residence at his Nordend street address (see CR #1). He subsequently will travel to Camp Valka to interview Ivan MOTZAKOVA (see CR #3, paragraph 3B).
