Dear Hertin,

Do not wonder that this time you get this letter sooner than usual.

I received your post card dated Sept. 8, 51. It is not clear yet how is your old man with his health and his new job. Write me more detailed about that. How is my god-son Zigfrids?

Now I will tell you a little about me and my friends. I live all the same, but during the war I have lost much valuables. The main thing I am sorry for is losing the the finely bound book "Ninas Pasacinas" which Kocins and Verners had presented me. This book with its knowledge of life would be very useful nowadays. It will be a great pleasure to me if you would have this or a similar book you could send me. Several of our old acquaintances are severely ill as a result of the war years and are recuperating somewhere in Sanatoriums. Old trout fisher Edgarins, Feliks and many others. Edmunds already died in a sanatorium. After a long time recuperating in the sanatorium the following have recovered and returned: agrinom Kārlis Nuschens and Aleksandrs Nuschens, also Gunārs Tejkalns. Kugītis is fighting hard with his sickness. It is doubtful whether he will recover.

Also mine and my sisters Ilmarina health is not in a perfect shape, but at present we keep on. Who knows for how long? As you know yourself that the climate here is damp and unhealthy and the illness can progress very fast. Now I have complained too much about our troubles. Doctors advise us to change climate, and since our work is not very important here, maybe with your and Verners help it would be possible for us to change to a dryer climate. In this respect I and my sister Ilmarina

would like to ask your and Aunts Guste serious advice and assistance. Talk it over Hertin, with other doctors. May be you could send us medicine or a receipe how we should live in the future. I am very interested how are you all really getting along. I will also be happy to talk things over with someone from your side, because I have interesting things to talk about.

If you receive this letter, answer without delay whatever you have decided is the best.
