Born circa 1908.  
Height - 5'10" (1.78 m)  
Heavy build - round face - black hair - blue eyes - dark complexion  
Wife: Dr. Elisabeth HERBST, Potsdam-Rehbruecke, Brinkmannstr. 14  
Chief, Investigator on Staff of the Inspekteur of SD/Sipo for Wehrkreis VI Duesseldorf (1944-1945)  
Formerly Regierungs Rat in Gestapo and Assistant Dienststelleleiter in Potsdam.
- b. HERBST, Fritz Dr.  
SS Ostuf. RSHA, Berlin-Zehlendorf during World War II  
V-mann employed by Amt VI VI.  
Resided Gartenstr. 13, Berlin-Zehlendorf  
Born on 2 May 1897 in Eisenach, Germany
- c. HERBST, Friedrich  
Reg. Ass. Amt 1F 3a, RSHA in Berlin, Germany

2. Headquarters' Latvian cards revealed information on the following individuals who may be identical with or related to the individuals who are mentioned in paragraphs 1b, 1d and 1e of Reference A:

a. PALKAVNIEKS, FNU

"POB: Latvia. PALKAVNIEKS fought on the Republican side in the Spanish Civil War. He was a member of a Soviet Latvian Election Committee in Cecis, Latvia, after World War II."

b. PALKAVNIEKS, Ja(nis?)

"PALKAVNIEKS, Ja. was the director of the Dailes Drama Theater in Riga, Latvia, after World War II. He resided at Suvorova iela 22, Riga, Latvia, in 1961."

c. LULLE, FNU

"DOB: circa 1915. She was in a slave labor camp in Mordavia, Russia, in 1954. She is a physician and her specialty is internal diseases. Married and has several grown up children."

d. ANDERSONS, Eduards Jr.

DOB: circa 1914 or 1915; POB: Latvia

"A Latvian convict seen in Vorkuta mine # 8 after World War II. He had a brother, Konstantins A. ANDERSONS. The father's first name was also Eduards. The fate of Konstantins ANDERSONS is unknown. Eduards Jr. was a student at the Latvian State University as was Konstantins, who studied economics. They belonged to the Latvian Student Fraternity "SELONIA". Eduards Jr. was a good athlete and a former member of the All-Latvian Basketball Team. He was sentenced to twenty-five (25) years of hard labor in Siberia. A former friend of his is Ilmars RUPNERS [ ]

According to Headquarters' files, RUPNERS is an agent of the Latvian KGB who was in contact with at least one AECOB REDSOX agent in Latvia in the early 1950's.

3. There are no Headquarters traces on the individuals mentioned in subparagraphs 1c, 1f, and 1g of Reference A.

4. AERADISH, the cryptonym mentioned in Reference B, ~~is~~ assigned to Identity 1 (see separate cover attachment) as requested in paragraph 2 of reference C. Headquarters file numbers for AERADISH operational and production folders are 74-6-377/5 and 74-6-377/6, respectively.
