1. Reference is indeed interesting. We agree that the information in paragraph 2 B, C, and D certainly appears to pertain to Subject. On the other hand, paragraph 2 E could pertain to UJDROWSY, UJDRUM, or any other heretofore unidentified penetrations of the GFR security complex in addition to Subject. We do not recall having been informed that Subject attempted to halt the UJDROWSY/UJDRUM interrogations. In the absence of details on this incident we are unable to judge its significance. Leaving that aside, what we have, in essence, is an indication that the Soviet Bloc has in its possession information which could have been used, or could be used, for blackmail purposes. While this clearly makes Subject a poor security risk, it hardly comes into the category of evidence of treasonable connections. The Eastern publicity campaign against Subject indeed poses numerous riddles which lend themselves to a variety of possible interpretations. An attempt to draw firm conclusions as to the relationship, if any, between that campaign and the existing suspicions against Subject would, in our opinion, be a sterile exercise.

2. We concur in the proposal contained in paragraph 3 of Reference that this information be passed to the Germans. In this case, because of the nature of the lead, we see no harm in making the information available to UTILITY as well as to CAVATA. Our comments on the suggestion contained in the attachment to Reference are being forwarded under separate cover.
