PROGRESS REPORT - December 1950 - []

11. Grapsner 9 was asked to provide information on the contacts and friends of REICHRATH, a CIC informant, of Leo MAIER, Ignaz MAIER and BRITSCH of the Linz Police. The information was requested in order to clarify ~~Grapsner~~ [] connections with various Linz Police officials (see MAVA-7168). REICHRATH's investigation, incidentally, will be largely academic because of his departure for permanent resettlement in Australia is imminent. [] so questioned [] on the activities of SANITZER, subject of MAV-2216 (see MAV-W-3011). [] could offer no new information at the time but said he would check with FOCKE, fnu, in Braunau. FOCKE is a former associate of SANITZER's with whom the latter still maintains contact and who may know identities of the former SD and Gestapo men likely to accept SANITZER's offer. Apparently FOCKE is the subsource of the original report.
