1. The following unit designations for cover use by the 7821 Composite Group have been registered at this headquarters:

6211 Engineer Service Company
6434 Signal Operations Company

2. The 7821 Composite Group, European Command, is hereby authorized to use the unit designations indicated in paragraph 1, in lieu of its official designation for purposes of registering separate installations and vehicles, for obtaining travel permits and other routine papers for individuals, or for other cover purposes where, because of reasons of operational security, it is not desired that the 7821 Composite Group, European Command, appear publicly as the sponsoring organization.

3. The authority given in paragraph 2, extends only to the use of these cover designations for specific operational purposes and in no way affects the present status of the 7821 Composite Group, European Command.

4. It is desired that the contents of this letter receive as limited dissemination as is consistent with fulfilling the requirements of paragraph 2.
