 - a. UPSWING probably has the capability of staffing this one out completely on its own with no assistance from KUBARK.
 - b. It is difficult to formulate a T/O&E for any such project without projecting the tactics and techniques for the operation.
 - c. The passing of such information to UPSWING involves policy decisions which cannot be made in the field.
 - d. Information on the latest thinking and equipment in this field is more readily available at Headquarters.
