1. Set out below is the content of a cable note from [] to [] of
28 April 1959:

"1. Informal talks held with Major Moon, G2 USAREUR, regarding bilateral
staybehind. Consensus UTILITY approval necessary with assurance his
backstopping with other German agencies. Munich recommended following action:

"a. USAREUR give outline project and desired UPSWING support in
writing to MB/LB.

"b. MUNI sound out UTILITY informally and advise his opinion.

"c. USAREUR reframe proposal and submit formally to [] or
request meeting [General] Osborne/UTILITY to present in [] with
KUBARK attending.

"d. Subsequent negotiations direct USAREUR/UPSWING with MB/LB
attendance.

"2. Major Moon indicated USAREUR desires direct negotiations with UPSWING.
He felt MUNI should sit in all discussions view other UPSWING staybehind
activities and joint war planning past years.

"3. Request FRAN concurrence and support in dealing with []"

2. On 24 April 1959 Alverson talked with Lt. Col. [] and
requested that with respect to point 1.c. in the cable note above, the reframed pro-
posal be submitted to [] for coordination before any attempt to arrange a
meeting between General Osborne and UTILITY. [] they would
follow these instructions and that they on their part []
before talking to UPSWING. With respect to [] notes,
Colonel Rhodney stated that, while Army would like to have their
talk to UPSWING representatives with respect to the [] they
agree that a member of the Munich Base sit in []
