Personnel were quartered in Camp Kassarine, where two kitchen-dining rooms and one latrine were assigned. No privately-owned vehicles were brought on the post. Excellent air support was furnished by EAOB as requested in reference, with minor agreed changes in the times of three missions, which were enforced by the weather. alternate date. The accurate approach and drop performance of the L-20, which was used in all exercises, made a good impression on the UPHILL participants. In order to initially attract the attention of the pilots to the daylight panel pattern, which is difficult to see from a low-flying airplane, red smoke candles were employed as the airplane approached.

5. In addition to reception of parachute drops as scheduled in reference, all groups took training in:

a. Burial of RCL equipment and preparation of empty burial locations to accommodate parachutes and cargoes.

b. Establishing and servicing DLD's and arranging neutral meetings.

6. It was noted that the recruiting problem is still serious, with only three recruits claimed in FOX/SOUTH during the past year, and only one new agent in training. The same excuses (over-employment and lack of interest) are given by the Case Officers and Staff.

Physical Descriptions
UJLNTIL

1. @FELIX, circa 55 years, 5'10", 180 lbs., full long white pompadour, blue eyes, pink complexion, aquiline nose, thin lips, fourth upper right tooth missing, receding dimpled double chin, large oval face, medium sized effeminate hands, large belly and broad beam. General impression -- sour, cold suspicious.
2. @FREY, circa 45 years, 5'4", 150 lbs., auburn hair straight back, slanted blue eyes, ruddy complexion, short straight round-tipped nose, flat square face, normal chin, small soft hands, wedding ring. Characteristics -- sullen suspicious look -- hands on hips and belly protruding -- nastily argumentative with his colleagues.
3. @HAGMANN, circa 50 years, 5'5", 140 lbs., brown hair straight back curling behind ears, balding in front, brown complexion, green-brown eyes, smile wrinkles, thin typically Jewish nose, ruddy cheeks, slim brown unringed hands. Characteristic -- merry mood.
4. @VOGEL, circa 45 years, 5'5", 150 lbs., mouse brown hair parted left, smooth forehead, slate blue eyes, reading glasses, short flat nose, third and fourth teeth on lower left gold, undershot jaw with bad malocclusion on left side, flat round face, brown complexion, stooped narrow shoulders, broad beam, medium hands, wedding ring, speaks good English.
5. @ROFNER, born 20 July 1897, 5'5", 180 lbs., gray fringe, smooth forehead, pink mole right temple, short round-tipped nose, protruding blue eyes, rounded chin, hands medium soft with tapered fingers, no rings. Leader of Team U/1.
6. @DROSTE, 47 years, 5'5", 145 lbs., brown hair straight back, balding crown, brown complexion, green-blue eyes, sloping forehead, medium aquiline nose, lean face, medium strong clean hands.
7. @NOLL, circa 55 years, 5'5", 135 lbs., long brown-gray frizzy hair standing up, very sloping forehead, blue eyes, bushy eyebrows, long straight nose, long face, prominent chin, both eyeteeth gold-filled, disproportionately large strong clean hands (size 10-11) with little callousing. Wood carver, strict vegetarian, very merry disposition.
8. @TELLHEIM (true name or ZENTRAL alias TEJLERMANN) new member of UPHILL Staybehind Staff (Section 961), an ex-civil airlines pilot (sometimes called Major), circa 48 years, 5'6", 170 lbs., curly auburn hair, ruddy complexion, weathered wrinkled face, blue eyes, short straight nose, square face, loose lips, right eyetooth gold, strong square hands, speaks good English with hoarse German accent.
