EGMA-55611, 20 Sep 61.</p> <p>1. <u>UPHILL War Plans Staff:</u></p> <p>a. <u>Berlin Evacuation.</u> UPHILL plans to effect a substantial reduction in the number of staffers and dependents residing in Berlin which will be completed by aircraft 31 December 1961 (See Ref A). In this connection, UPHILL asked whether use of military could be assured to assist them in event civil flights were interrupted (Ref B indicates reply).</p> <p>b. <u>UJLIFELESS.</u> UPHILL expects to have their initial shipment of materials for the permanent station ready for loading during the month of November. Request for military shipment will be initiated as soon as list of materials, weights and cubes has been furnished and assembly point for loading determined.</p> <p>c. <u>Redeployment Destination in France:</u> Military Letter of Instruction has been received to cover the UPHILL redeployment of their STAFFEL II from Munich to Clermont-Ferrand, France. Insofar as is known to MLB, UPHILL has no existing facilities at this destination at present.</p> <p>d. <u>JBLIMBERS/ACC.</u> UPHILL intends to augment their current Paris Office with one additional person who will have the responsibility of acting as UPHILL emergency delegate to ACCG pending arrival of a permanent delegation. It is believed that @DRUXA (an active major) has been selected for this post and will join his new station during the coming winter months.</p> <p>2. <u>UJLENTIL:</u></p> <p>a. Training was conducted at the Hohenfels Military Reservation for staff, case officers, and three agent teams during the period 10 - 16 September 1961 in accordance with report submitted by Reference C.</p> <p>b. A team made up of staff and case officers of UJLENTIL departed from Munich on 24 September for the island of BORKUM in the North Sea where joint exercises with the <u>Bundesmarine</u> involving use of maritime beacons and operation of maritime reception teams were accomplished.</p> <p>c. UJLENTIL Staff expects to conduct joint border crossing exercises with representatives of the French clandestine service during the month of October in the vicinity of Pirmasens-Zweibruecken.</p> <p>3. <u>Tactical Staybehind (Section 925):</u></p> <p>No change in status.</p> <p>4. <u>UJKEVEL:</u></p> <p>a. A landing zone exercise involving a night landing of a light plane at Schwabach was scheduled for 9 August with alternate dates on 10 and 11 August. UJKEVEL had assembled all their case officers in the vicinity of Nuernberg to observe and participate but the air support did not materialize; allegedly the aircraft was not available on 9 August and could not fly on 10 and 11 August due to weather conditions.</p> <p>b. The GARTEN Section of UJKEVEL will be engaged in supporting the joint French/UPHILL border crossing exercise involving UJLENTIL. The UJKEVEL Lines teams</p>

5. Sabotage School:

a. A course of instruction was held for three case officers and two EM during the months of August and September which concluded with four days demolition practice on the Bad Toelz demolition range 26 - 30 September.

b. The three case officers who completed a one month's orientation course, will take up their duties of spotting and recruiting personnel for small teams (not to exceed 4 men) which will be spotted along the DDR - CSR borders. These teams will be trained and supplied with a view to their infiltration into target areas for resistance activities in case of hostilities.

c. @RETZLAUF completed the Counter-Guerrilla course at the Special Forces Warfare School, Fort Bragg, returning to Munich during mid-September.

d. Members of the Sabotage Staff plan to attend briefings on the coming Exercise DEVIL SPREAD at Evreux, France and to send observers to the field in the vicinity of Bad Toelz.
