<u>Personnel of Amt VI/ML., RSHA</u>

20. Dr. Wirsing. He took off in the night on which American Troops reached the northern outskirts of Munich (28th or 29th April) from the Badabbling aerodrome in a night fighter for Luebeck to report to <u>SHELL - ENBERG</u> there. <u>SHELLENBERG</u> had ordered that <u>WIRSING</u> should report to him in a radio message to <u>STEIMLER</u> and <u>SANDBERGER</u> . Whether he arrived <u>SANDBERGER</u> does not know.			
<u>Reorganization of Amt VI</u>			
During March 1945 <u>SHELLENBERG</u> formed a plan to cut the organization of Amt VI to about 30% of its original size. At the same time informal discussions were held between <u>SHELLENBERG</u> and his Gruppenleiter: <u>SANDBERGER</u> , <u>STEIMLE</u> , <u>PAEFFGEN</u> , <u>RAPP</u> , and <u>BOEINING</u> regarding measures to maintain a secret intelligence service when only islands of military would remain in Germany.

Discussion of the plans was based on the assumption that there would be enough time to make complete preparations. None of the plans was carried out, but a last minute streamlining of Amt VI was attempted toward the end of April 45 by <u>KALTENBRUNNER</u> with the aid of <u>WANEK</u> . <u>SHELLENBERG</u> was no longer available. <u>SANDBERGER</u> had left <u>BERLIN</u> in mid-April on <u>SHELLENBERG'S</u> order to evacuate to the South some elements of Amt VI which were temporarily in Thuringia.

<p>d. <u>Surrender Policy</u></p> <p>The question uppermost in the minds of members of Amt VI during the months immediately preceding the final defeat of Germany was whether to surrender to the Western Allies or to Russia. By surrendering to one of the two it might be possible to negotiate alliance against the other. SANDBERGER describes SCHELLENBER as a politician rather than a dogmatic National Socialist, and as being favorably disposed towards the Allies.</p> <p>.....</p>
