| 1) Although nominally subordinate to <u>SHELLENBERG</u> , <u>SKORZENY</u> owes present position to <u>KALTENBRUNNER</u> | | | | |
| 2) <u>SHELLENBERG</u> 's opposition to Skorseny partly based on fear that latter's inclusion in Amt VI would "blow" <u>SHELLENBERG</u> 's organization. Former group represented by <u>SHELLENBERG</u> and Dr. <u>SIX</u> , an SD official at Auswaertiges Amt; latter group represented by RSHA head Kaltenbrunner, Gestapo head Mualler, SD head for Germany who is Ohlendorf, and by Skorseny. To avoid loss of Amt VI, Kaltenbrunner obliged to tolerate <u>SHELLENBERG</u> who, realizing potential danger to himself, personally supervises all Amt VI activities excepting those of Skorseny. | | | | |
| 3) <u>SHELLENBERG</u> believes all SD personnel compromise ^d but that his own part in BEST-STEVENS affair unknown. | | | | |
