THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS QUOTED VERBATIM

Plinio SALGADO

The Brazilian Integralists were of considerable interest to the foreign intelligence branch of the German Security Service (Amt VI, Sipo and SD). It was reported in September 1944 that Heinrich BARON, German correspondent and Assistant Press Attache in Lisbon, had made contact, at the instigation of Press Attache Dr. Herbert WISSMANN, with Plinio SALGADO, for the purpose of keeping in close touch with nationalist movements in South America. WISSMANN and BARON both worked for the Security Service. It was later reported that SALGADO probably had agents in South America working under Adolf NASSENSTEIN (see separate report attached herewith). The former head of Amt. VI, Walter SCHELLENBERG, under interrogation in 1945, gave the name "Plivo il SALGADO" in a list of Amt. VI representatives and agents in neutral countries.
