1. WIRA-1183 of 20 October 1952 and WIRA-1205 of 22 October 1952 report that in March 1952, Walter SCHELLENBERG, who stated that he was born on 16 January 1910 in Saarbruecken, was staying in Verbania (Novara), Italy, with his wife. During a train trip, he became ill, and his wife had him leave the train at Piacenza. After checking with his doctor in Verbania, it was decided to transport SCHELLENBERG by ambulance to the clinic of Prof. FORNACA in Turin. There SCHELLENBERG died, on 31 March 1952, of heart failure, cirrhosis of the liver, and infection of the spleen.
