The British source reported that Subject was with Abwehr, Poland. In charge of Kommando SCHLAGER, Warsaw, which directed activities of 3 Abw. Kommandos on the Russian front. Former chief of Ast Vienna. Commanded an Abwehrtrupp during the campaign in Greece.

Formerly a high official in the German C.I.D. (Counter Intelligence?) transferred to the German IS in 1933. One of the first Germans to enter Athens leading one of the mobile intelligence units. June 1941, took charge of the German IS operations on the Russian front, HQ Warsaw.

Headed Stab Walli 1941-46 in Thuringia. Worked from 1935-38 in Ast Muenchen and from 1938-41 was chief of III F Ast Vienna. At the end of the war, Stab WALLI was referred to as F A L St. OST. Subject's wife lives at Nuernberg-Erlenstegen. Born 17 Jan 1893 in Muenchen.
