

Summary of Archives information on
Heinz SCHMALSCHLAEGER

1. LONDON X2 PTS-2, Folder 70 (PF602,395) Box 2.
Name appears on a Summary of traces sheet with aliases HELLER, TOBIER AND DOBIER and reference to SHAEF Card 49616.
2. LONDON X2 Pts 2, Document 4, folder 4, box 2
SCHMALSCHLAEGER, in addition to being head of Walli III, appears also to have been head of a combined staff comprising WALLI I, II, III until May 1942, when Walli I broke away.
3. WGLA 10896, 3240-7-414 transmits roll of negatives of a study based on German IS.WW II experience entitled "Anleitung fuer Befrager, Spezialgebiet UdSSR". It was prepared by ex-Col "Heinrich" (Heinz SCHMALSCHLAEGER (WGLA 10504), who loaned it to ZIPPER.
4. WASH Reg Op 1 (MCH 005-1202) The only sources of the information collated in subject report (USFET CI-SIR No. 4 on the Foreign Department and Counter-Intelligence Department of NKGB) were Obst-Lt SCHMALSCHLAEGER, Sonderfuhrers ARELS and KAZOWSKI of Lt III Ost. The citing of specific Soviet agent-operations was done by memory by these three men who are continuing to serve as a living reference library at MISC Oberursel.
5. ATHENS X-2 Pts-1 Folder 2 (29). Major SCHMALSCHLAEGER - German officer who led a mobile Intelligence Unit into Greece, at time of invasion. Later transferred to Warsaw in charge of Ger I.S. on Russian front. (OSS Greek handbook - German I.S. in Greece.
