2. These reports were prepared under the supervision of Subject of KARL-1014. They represent the greater part of the work performed by Subject and his staff during their long sojourn at ECIC. However, Subject has also served in an advisory capacity to the CI Section of ECIC on matters pertaining to the Soviet and satellite intelligence services.

3. We are not able to give a satisfactory answer to paragraph 2 of MGMA-607 since the ECIC case officers who have handled Subject from the time of his arrival at Oberursel in 1945 have all returned to the United States.

The best informed of the case officers was [redacted], who left Oberursel in May of this year. None of the present SCIC staff members are well enough acquainted with this case to know of Subject's relationship with Colonel BAUN's organization. However, [redacted] has pointed out on several occasions that Subject was most contemptuous of Colonel BAUN personally, and that he had a very low opinion of the personnel and methods being used by the group. Although it is recalled that [redacted] once stated that Subject refused to have anything to do with Colonel BAUN and associates, it cannot be stated with certainty that he at no time worked with or had any connections with REYSTONKA.

4. The photographs requested in paragraph 4 are expected in the near future and will be forwarded upon receipt.
