1. Attached herewith are seven photographs for inclusion in a photo spread to be provided to the BfV in connection with their attempt to identify fnu EICHMANN, whose name has come up in connection with a BfV double agent operation against the Czech Intelligence Service in East Berlin. Four of these photos are of Czech personalities stationed in East Berlin while the remaining three are Czechs stationed at the Czech Military Mission in West Berlin. These latter photos are being included since all three personalities in general terms fulfill the physical description of EICHMANN as provided by the BfV and, although not definitely proven to be engaging in espionage, they are certainly three of the most likely candidates among the personnel stationed at the CMM.

For your information there is a Jaroslav Antos now stationed at the Czech Embassy in East Berlin who is listed according to the latest DDR Protocol List as a Third Secretary with a home address of Berlin-Niederschoesenhausen, Pfeilstr. 14. Antos' name has also come up in connection with CALLIKAK telephone coverage of the Czech Military Mission. Antos has called on a number of occasions requesting that a member of the Military Section of the CMM come to the Embassy in East Berlin which has led us to place him tentatively in the Military Section of the Embassy. In this context we would appreciate receiving a copy of the picture of Antos and additional information on him or the security flap in which he was involved in Switzerland. In addition, other addressee traces are requested on
