We are in complete agreement with Headquarters that UPHILL was very much at fault for not carefully checking out the political ramifications of the actions they proposed before making the suggestion cited in 19595. We also feel that these events reflect a failure by UPHILL to make necessary plans and carry through on a suggestion which showed strong indications of benefiting the Western community. In addition, records were somewhat surprised when the appropriate UPHILL officer emphasized the lack of trust UPHILL had in its agent and in effect retreated from his previous position.

2. Unfortunately the meeting on 6 August between GRAMM and ANTOS failed to materialize, although the agent waited over half an hour in front of the Hotel Adria. When no one appeared, GRAMM phoned the Czech Embassy and asked for REZEK. REZEK immediately recognized GRAMM's predicament - apparently he had been briefed by ANTOS - and told GRAMM to take a taxi to the Embassy. GRAMM allegedly claimed that he didn't have any DME's, but REZEK told him that payment would be made to the taxi driver upon arrival at the Embassy. GRAMM arrived at the Czech Embassy without incident and met briefly with REZEK. He turned over the UPHILL prepared Spielmaterial, but received less money than that usually provided. REZEK claimed that "EICHMANN" (ANTOS) was out of town and unavailable for the meeting. REZEK also refused to provide GRAMM with transportation to the airport or any point in the West Sector, and would only give him some DME's for a taxi.

3. It appears that the CIS is withdrawing from the operation, and with the Berlin travel restrictions for West German citizens it seems unlikely that another opportunity will present itself to arrest ANTOS. Needless to say, a meeting between GRAMM and ANTOS in West Germany seems very unlikely, but should such a meeting be scheduled we will press for UPHILL to take executive action.
