<p>1. Reference concerned the meeting in Berlin between UPHILL's double agent Alias GRAM and his Czech case officer, Jaroslav ANTOS <input type="checkbox"/> in late November 1960 which was followed by a contact in Zurich which took place on 7 January 1961. During a recent discussion we had with @KUTZBACH, he amplified his description of the 7 January contact by stating that the meeting was very brief, and @GRAM claimed that he only received two envelopes; one with 700 DMW's (his salary) and the other with a letter from his sister, Erika MOTTAROVA, who resides in Czechoslovakia. He did not receive new EEI's.</p> <p>2. The UPHILL counter-surveillance of the meeting was carried out by a man and a woman, and the man was in an upstairs hotel room from which the attached pictures were taken. The woman had a camera concealed in a fur muff, but for unexplained reasons (probably too much muff) none of the pictures she snapped came out.</p> <p>3. Both GRAM and the UPHILL counter-surveillance team agreed on the following description of the Zurich contact:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Born circa 1915 to 1920 About 160-165 cms tall (circa 5'3½") Slim but medium-strong figure (schlank-mittelkraeftig) Round head, full face Thick glasses with dark frames.</p> <p>GRAM stated that the CIS contact spoke German with a Swiss accent, but since UPHILL feels that GRAM may be playing for both Czech intelligence and UPHILL we cannot be certain that this statement is true. GRAM and the UPHILL surveillants described the contact as being of average appearance and of the "kleinbuergerliche" type. Attached are the pictures of the meeting between the Czech IS contact and GRAM. They are exceptionally worthless, and appear almost as though the contact knew he was being photographed. Certainly they will be of no assistance in making any kind of identification and may be destroyed after their amusement value has been served. You will note that UPHILL blotted out the picture of their ace agent GRAM.</p> <p>4. GRAM travelled to East Berlin and made contact with ANTOS circa 25 February 1961, and at that meeting was told that he should plan to come to East Berlin for several days training in May. He was also told that in the future, meetings would not be held so often. During the discussion of training, ANTOS stated that it would include training in a new S/W system and in radio transmitting and receiving.</p> <p>5. EE and <input type="checkbox"/>: We realize that the scanty physical description provided in paragraph 3 as well as the extremely poor photographs make a possible identification of the individual with whom GRAM came into contact almost impossible, but any ideas you have as to the man's identity would be appreciated.</p>

1. Reference concerned the meeting in Zurich between UPHILL, an agent alias GRAM and his Czech contact, [redacted], late November 1960 which was followed by a meeting on 7 January 1961. During a recent debriefing, [redacted] amplified his description of the contact, who was very brief, and GRAM claimed that he was paid 700 DM's (his salary) and the other with [redacted] GOTTLAROVA, who resides in Czechoslovakia.

2. The UPHILL counter-surveillance of the meeting was carried out by a man and a woman, and the man was in an upstairs room from which attached pictures were taken. The woman had a camera concealed in a bag but for unexplained reasons (probably she was not supposed to be there) snipped came out.

3. Both GRAM and the UPHILL counter-surveillance team saw the following description of the Zurich contact:

Born circa 1915 to 1920
About 160-165 cm tall (circa 5' 3")
Slim but well-proportioned figure (rather "mittelbaueartig")
Round nose, full lips
Thick eyebrows

GRAM stated that the CIA contact was [redacted] since UPHILL feels that GRAM may be [redacted] UPHILL we cannot be certain that this [redacted] surveillants described the contact as being of a "Kleinbürgerliche" type. Attached are the pictures of the Czech IS contact and GRAM. They are [redacted] almost as though the contact knew he was being photographed. This will be of no assistance in making any kind of identification. The pictures destroyed after their assessment value had been determined. UPHILL blotted out the picture of [redacted]

4. GRAM travelled to East Berlin [redacted] 25 February 1961, and at that meeting [redacted] to East Berlin for several days training [redacted] the future, meetings would not be held [redacted] training, ANTON stated that it would include [redacted] and in radio transmitting and receiving.

5. EE and [redacted] provided in paragraph 3 as well as [redacted] possible identification of the contact [redacted] almost impossible, but any identification [redacted] appreciated.
