REFERENCE(S)	<p>A. EGMA-54318, 4 April 1961</p> <p>B. EGMA-53881, 13 March 1961</p> <p>1. With regard to UPHILL's Fall MONOGRAM, MLB may wish to pass the following BOB comments to UPHILL.</p> <p>2. It is improbable that (fnu) NOVOTNY is identical with Dr. Pavel NOVOTNY [] former Counsellor of the Czech Embassy in East Berlin and onetime deputy chief of the Czech Military Mission. Pavel NOVOTNY is believed to have been transferred to a responsible position in Territorial Department (3) (Germany and Austria) of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Prague. His former quarters at Berlin/Niederschöenhausen, Pfeilstrasse 12, are currently assigned to his replacement, Rudolf REZEK. [] who has been implicated in "Fall MONOGRAM".</p> <p>3. We consider it likely that (fnu) NOVOTNY may be identical with attaché of the Czech Embassy, Robert THER. [] a suspected Czech intelligence officer who worked with Jaroslav ANTOS. [] in Switzerland in March 1956. It has been reported that THER shares a set of offices with ANTOS in the Czech Embassy building, (EGBA-63128, 22 April 1960, information dated January 1960, not to MLB), and we assume they continue to work together. THER resides at Berlin/Niederschöenhausen, Pfeilstrasse 17. The description Alias GRAM furnished UPHILL on NOVOTNY would seem to fit THER. Therefore, we suggest that Alias GRAM be shown THER's picture in the photo album of Czech intelligence agents held by COS/G.</p> <p>3. BOB has had some success in identifying a number of the vehicles used by the Czechs in greater Berlin. We can verify that ANTOS "sold" his Opel Rekord with the cream top and coral red bottom to an officer of the Czech Military Mission and substituted a Mercedes in March 1960 (EGMA-49595, 7 June 1960). It would be appreciated if MLB would determine whether NOVOTNY uses this or a different car when he meets Alias GRAM.</p> <p>5.
