1. UPHILL's Alias GRAMM, who has been reported previously as identical with

Hans SCHOEBEL ()

was recently instructed to come to Vienna for a meeting with the Czech IS. In Vienna, he met with a new case officer whom he allegedly had never seen before. The initial contact took place near the Bristol Hotel on 16 June 1962 and was surveilled by UPHILL. The CIS representative was described by @GRAMM and the UPHILL surveillants as follows:

Born circa 1930-32
175 cms tall
Thin but strong figure
Wrinkled brow and slightly receding hairline at temples
Speaks rather poor German
Ring on left ring finger
Very short finger nails, as though he has been manching on same
Chain smoker
Wavy hair, combed straight back

Transmitted herewith for COS/Vienna; COS/Germany/^{BOB}and Chief, EE are copies of photographs of the above described individual (marked #1 on the reverse side of the print). The photographs were taken by the UPHILL surveillance team, at least one of whom was in an upstairs room in the Bristol Hotel.

2. The UPHILL surveillance team also succeeded in photographing three other individuals, at least one of whom was a counter-surveillant for the meeting. #2 was observed walking along beside #1. #3 was seated not far from the meeting place on a bench, and was holding a camera and tripod in his hand. #4 is a woman who appeared to loiter in the area of the meeting.

3. When passing us the above information, @KUTZBACH commented that GRAMM received more of the usual general EEI's, reporting on specific individuals, reporting any information available on UPHILL, etc.. About 24 July 1962, GRAMM received a letter from his sister

Resides Prague ^{CZECHOSLOVAKIA}
Probably Czech IS ^{SUBT PROBABLE CZECH IS AGENT}

who stated that she intends to travel to Leipzig and Berlin in the near future. Although she did not state that she might go to West Berlin, UPHILL suspects that she might visit Wolfgang KLOSE. We have advised the Munich CALLIKAK representative that we would like to have CALLIKAK on KLOSE reinstated.
