We have reviewed our photo albums and have concluded that the individual who is pictured in the photographs marked #1, which were forwarded with the Reference, may be identical with Stanislaw ZDARSKY who is the CSA representative in Vienna. If this identification is correct, the information from Fall MONOGRAMM represents the first firm evidence we have received that ZDARSKY has intelligence functions. The individual who is pictured in the photographs marked #2 appears to be identical with Slavoj FROUS, Third Secretary at the Czech Legation in Vienna, who was previously identified by a highly sensitive source as a CIS staff officer. We are unable to identify the individuals in photographs 3 and 4.

2. Forwarded herewith for MLB only as Attachment A is a biographic data sheet on ZDARSKY which was previously sent to Vienna with EAVW-16644 dated 19 September 1962. The information on this sheet may be passed to UPHILL. Forwarded as Attachment B is a biographic data sheet on FROUS which also was sent to Vienna with EAVW-16644. The information on this sheet which is not marked NOFORN may be passed to UPHILL. Under no circumstances is UPHILL to be passed the information from the highly sensitive source, although you may advise them that FROUS is suspected of engaging in intelligence activities for the Czechs. Attachment C contains photos of ZDARSKY (Photo A) and FROUS (Photo B). We should appreciate your asking UPHILL to show these photos to alias GRAMM and the UPHILL surveillance team to see if our identifications of these two individuals can be confirmed.
