We orally discussed the information in reference with UPHILL's @KUTZBACH, the case officer responsible for Fall MONOGRAM. @KUTZBACH said that there has been little activity in the case and that to all intents and purposes it is dead. UPHILL doesn't have any recent picture of Erika GOTTLAROVA, but @KUTZBACH said he'd forward us a rather old photograph. She has now moved to the Soviet Zone (with her husband), but UPHILL allegedly learned this independently since she has not informed her brother of the move.</p> <p>2. We advised @KUTZBACH that we had tentatively identified the photograph #1 (attached to EGMA 59721 dated 16 August 1962) as ZDARSKY and that photograph #2 appeared to be identical with Slavoj FROUS who is suspected of engaging in intelligence activities for the Czechs.</p> <p>3. UPHILL does not use the Czech IS Photo Album, because they have never been given the identities of the individuals in the Album (per EE instructions). @KUTZBACH feels, with some justification, that there is no point in showing a surveillance team a series of photos when the UPHILL case officer doesn't know what pictures are involved, whether the individual is alive or dead, intelligence type or not, or possibly is assigned in an entirely different hemisphere. However, UPHILL does have its own rogues gallery, and uses same when debriefing agents and surveillance teams (when appropriate). A spread of photos of those individuals known to UPHILL to be active in Austria was shown to the surveillance team following the meeting with MONOGRAM.</p>
