<p>1. On 19 March, [ ] traveled to Copenhagen to surreptitiously monitor the CATIDE/[ ] operation directed against the Josef LENSKY/"GEIGE" meeting which was expected to take place in the dining room of the Skovriderkroen Hotel at 12:00 noon on 20 March 1965.</p> <p>2. Through pre-arranged planning, [ ] was able to register, under alias, in the room situated directly above the dining room where the meeting was to be held.</p> <p>3. Prior to the actual manning of the LP, [ ] requested that a member of the Station, who was fully conversant in the German language, be assigned to the LP during the monitoring. As a result of this request, [ ]'s wife was assigned the task.</p> <p>4. On the day of the meeting, monitoring began at 11:40 hours. During the course of the monitoring the entire band-width of the SRR-4 receiver was covered no less than a minimum of five (5) times. Particular emphasis was directed to those frequencies that are covered by the SRT-5 transmitter, i.e., 130-140 megacycles. Every signal received, i.e., taxi, aircraft, Danish, and Swedish radio transmissions were all positively identified by [ ]'s wife. At no time was any signal received that resembled dining room chatter or conversation. 5. It should be noted that the LP was situated at a point which was no more than approximately forty (40) feet from the farthest table in the dining rooms below the LP (see attached sketch). The star drawn on the sketch indicates the position of the LP receiver on the floor above.
