1. To complete your picture of our present relations with Camlet, I would like to inform you that I continue to maintain informal contact with him. No expenses are involved beyond the price of an occasional meal.

2. Although Camlet leaves a lot to be desired as a source of specific secret intelligence, he is very useful in keeping me abreast of general political trends in Bonn and Berlin. We have an informal and harmonious relationship. Camlet knows about my position with [] and seems to be quite flattered that his political opinions are solicited from that high level. In short, Camlet can be expected to continue as a useful contact but I would not classify him in the agent category.
