1. As stated in a separate message you are authorized to proceed with arrangements for [] and [] involving []

2. Regarding the use of CAMLET for [] cover: Our hesitation to approve this stems both from the reason stated in Reference A and the fresh addition this represents to CAMLET's knowledge of KUBARK operations in Berlin. Although this point was not made in Reference A we discussed it to some extent with [] during his last visit to Frankfurt. This is, of course, not []'s primary responsibility but should be looked into by Chief, BOB as a matter of general operational importance.

3. You have this headquarter's clearance to document [] via CAMLET after Chief, BOB has reviewed such action in terms of CAMLET's overall knowledgeability. If such a check results in a positive recommendation by [] you need not await further word to effect the arrangement.
