1. Perhaps we are pointing out the obvious, but CAMLET has proven his willingness to throw in his editorial lot, so to speak, with American foreign policy. Documentary evidence of this fact exists in the editorials and stories printed in TPOASIS during the present conference of foreign ministers. As evidence of this, please see Special Reports No. 7, 8, 9, forwarded under separate cover. Unless there be misunderstanding, we are not going overboard on all this and realize that the Berlin climate is considerably different from that in West Germany. However, it may be well to draw some comprehensive plans concerning the use of CAMLET as a political action agent, who, by his printed statements has committed himself to a considerable degree to the U.S. policy line.

2. The purpose of this dispatch is to solicit your ideas as to how CAMLET could be utilized as a political action agent from the long range point of view. We are thinking about this problem and it would be well to combine your and our thinking on this matter.
