1. ON 5 JUNE 62 CAMLET 1 PASSED TO [ ] SOME INFORMATION FROM CAMLET 11 WHO RECEIVED IT FROM AN UNIDENTIFIED INFORMANT DESCRIBED AS HERETOFORE WELL-INFORMED. INFORMANTS INFORMATION WAS SENT BY LETTER ON 28 MAY. ACCORDING TO THE INFORMANT, A FRIEND WHO KNOWS ULBRICHT WELL SAID A CONFLICT WITH CONVENTIONAL WEAPONS BETWEEN EAST AND WEST WOULD BE THREATENED BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR. THIS THREAT WOULD STRIKE SUCH FEAR IN THE WORLD THAT EAST GERMANY WOULD BE RECOGNIZED RATHER THAN RISK A NUCLEAR WAR.

2. CAMLET 1, IN PASSING THIS INFORMATION, SAID HE WAS UNABLE TO TELL WHETHER IT HAD ANY BASIS IN FACT. WE DID NOTHING WITH THIS INFORMATION WHEN WE RECEIVED IT BECAUSE WE FELT IT HAD LITTLE VALUE. NOW WE ARE SUBMITTING IT BECAUSE IT MAY BE A SOVIET EFFORT SOMEWHAT SIMILAR TO THAT REPORTED IN REF TO FOSTER FEAR AND CONFUSION IN THE WEST.

3. MLB- WE GAVE REF TO THE EMBASSY POLITICAL SECTION IN LINE WITH OUR POLICY AS STATED IN EGNA-22987.
