Apropos of the case of the card-carrying courier, we recall that a Pavla NIGRINOVA aka NIGRINOVA aka NIGRYNOVA is mentioned in the Viktor OLSOVSKY traffic. According to Marie SOPKOVA, she had been a Czech espionage agent and had seen OLSOVSKY in Prague on one of her trips there. This NYGRYNOWA was arrested by CIC for espionage and sentenced to a year in prison in February 1951. It is interesting that card files are an important element in both cases, and it may be that Subject and OLSOVSKY are part of the same net.
