SCHRUEBBERS:

1. PULL 3108 IN 14766 23 Jan 56

UTILITYs other main problem is establishment of close relationship with SCHRUEBBERS. UPSWING sponsored press stories have emphasized separation of functions. Close co-op utmost importance. UTILITY concerned by number internal security problems being brought to UPSWING by both official and non-official Germans who express lack of confidence in BfV. Has invited Schruebbbers to private dinner with him in Bonn end Jan at which he will propose close personal co-op in quietly handling such cases between them and begin common effort to educate officials on respective roles.

2. EGNA 10327 of 26 Nov 56

Discussion of progress of [] SCHRUEBBERS had only requested two additional Beamten for this work. "It was with some surprise therefore, that we learned that S had been heard to wonder aloud whether Koch and Weyde had been complaining to Lasby about the support they were getting within the BfV for their work. Refers to Pyka too but only in his official capacity.

3. EGNA 7984 27 Jan 1956

S and Radke came to COS by invitation on 20 Jan 56 for a briefing on Kubark activities. S definite appointment as President was confirmed 19 Dec 55. [] explained the place of Kubark in US government in D.C., [] on Kubark in Germany both as coordinator and operations-name checks RIS identification, BfV training school, handling of hostile agents of German nationality) Dragon program, [] read a paper on LcFLUTTER, and short demonstration of machine. S found visit interesting according to Nollau but he felt S had not been convinced by Lcflutter demonstration. Both visitors demonstrated a fair grasp of English and used English in conversations at lunch.

4. EGLA16007 22 Sept 55

"SCHRUEBBERS assignment to the BfV is happily regarded by BSSO/ [] people as another step forward in rebuilding the BfV position that was shattered by JOHN defection."

5. CS 81899 28 Dec 55

On 19 Dec 55 Heuss issued an order formally appointing S as president of the BfV. Adenauer recently sent the Interior Ministry a letter which gave responsibility for defensive CI functions to the BfV. This letter is regarded by W.German officials as an important step in granting the broader responsibilities to the BfV as the future national security authority.

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6. EGNA 7764 of Jan 56

Counter to our recommendations the BfV discussed German Security Measures with future Sov Emb. at 1 December meeting (group discussion with allied liaison officials). Nollau said Schurebbers insisted that S did so because he was not yet sufficiently experienced in the field of intell and security matters. All liaison officers and BfV section chiefs there.
