<p>" . . . Dr. SCHRUEEBERS . . . is scheduled to commence his new duties on 1 August. . . Dr. SCHRUEEBERS was not formally introduced to the luncheon guests. He was, however, taken around to the individual liaison officers and introduced to them by Vice President RADKE. He is a small man, approximately 5'7", neatly groomed and personable. By way of small talk, SCHRUEEBERS said that he has already received mail in his new capacity as BfV President. One person wrote that it was high time someone got on with the job, that first priority should be a thorough investigation of the government, including the Interior Minister. Another wrote that SCHLEWIG-HOLSTEIN would be an important target for investigation, the Land government was full of subversives who should be thrown out, the BfV ought to get busy on it.</p> <p>Through SCHRUEEBERS</p> <p>" . . . Dr. LUDWIG mentioned that SCHRUEEBERS would not yet be able to formally assume the title of President of the BfV since, legally, Dr. JOHN is still the official holder of the title and has not been formally absolved of his former function. BfV Dept. III head Rudolf MERZ, in reply to question as to whether SCHRUEEBERS should be addressed as "President," said to Mr. Shea that he should not be so addressed until he had served his probation period of three months; he was on loan from the North Rhine-Westphalian government during the probation period."</p>
