Para. 2.d. CAVATA-16 received Xmas gift: 1 bottle whisky or cognac  6.a. The overall briefing given C-16 and [ ] in December 1955 (EGQA-74741, 23 Feb 1956) gave the former his first real knowledge of the ODYOKE setup in Germany. ....Finally, the recent trip of CAVATA-16 and his companion gave them an additional look at our interests, a certain additional exposure to our personnel and certainly a better idea of our areas of interest and competence...  7.b. ...Also CAVATA-16 just before his PBPREM. trip made a couple of visits to (Nordrhein Westfalen) to try and convince them of the necessity to change their view (that N-W have no charter in CE field).  5. CAVATA telephone security is generally pretty ragged...we have been approached on several occasions recently by working level agencies requesting (installation of a teletype circuit between CAVATA and Bonn base)...We suggested they refer this to their superiors who should originate the suggestion to us. If this does not materialize, [ ] should be able to put this up to CAVATA-16 if and when he deems it appropriate. The groundwork has already been laid with Headquarters (see FRAN 7817, DIR 03194, EGNA-84111).
