 1951 GV L: leader of Branch RUHR of UV Rhine/Ruhr; operating Rhine/Ruhr area (Duesseldorf); living Trier.
 1952, late GV L: leader of UV 2978; operating area Rhine/Ruhr; living Trier.
 Dec Carl SCHUETZ, III g 00732, duty travel reported.
 1953 GV L: leader of UV 2978; operating area West Germany/East Germany; living Stuttgart.
 Mar Carl SCHUSTER, By I 180 294c, duty rail travel reported.
 Aug Carl SCHUETZ, HE 16 18772, duty rail travel reported, Sect. GV L.
 1954, Jan GV L redesignated Dienststelle 150.
 Jan Subject picked up on payroll with Section 150.
 Apr Transferred to Dienststelle 161; leader of operational CE Section (Zweigstelle e) under @ Hans DIRK. SCHUETZ has four case officers working under him. His deputy is Heinrich Josef HEISER (V-2629).
 Apr/May Two duty rail travel warrants requested for V-2978, D. 161, were issued to Walter GLOMB (Pass. 4906/52) accompanied by wife Eva GLOMB (Pass. 353/54); undetermined if this an error or a connection of Subject. (No other info on GLOMB to this date Feb 57).
 1955, Mar Subject, Fritz BUSCH (V-2982), and Hans Max CLEMMENS (V-2665) are old friends who served together in Sipo/W II, according to @ KUTZBACH, who says Subject attempts to protect tearful-under-pressure BUSCH.
 Jun Subject and [] as [] first met at Hotel Ketterer, on 26 June, in Stuttgart.
 Jun Subject a KUTZBACH, [] as [], [] as [], conferred in []'s Munich apt., on 29 June.
 Aug 3 Head of UV-2900; Optik'ed as being the head of Dienststelle 161's Zweigstelle e.
 Aug 23 Subject. during Stuttgart-Rotenberg restaurant meeting with [], stated his operations area is Wuerttemberg-Baden but with the anticipated expansion of his staff he expects to establish an operating sub-base in Berlin. ([] evaluates Subject as hard-working and shrewd.
 Oct Carl SCHUSTER, By I 180294, 7924 APT, duty rail travel reported.
 Dec Subject known to ALBERT V-2600.
 1956, May Subject apparently assigned to Bonn to beef up INDEX effort. This logical thing for him to be doing in that he knows the Rhineland, has many police and other contacts which might be useful.
 May 23 Subject transferred (although still carried on D. 24 T/O) to an independent office which he will run with headquarters in Cologne. Subject is taking Hans Max CLEMMENS (V-2665) with him.
 Nov Subject has suffered two mild heart attacks during the week of the 11th.
 Nov The following comprise the staff in SCHUETZ's office in Cologne: Chief, SCHUETZ; Deputy, @ HAFNER; Administration Officer, @ NIEBEL; CE staff member, @ WOLFF.
