Subject is used as a direct channel for planting WOFIRM-inspired stories or editorials in his paper and for suppressing stories inimical to U.S. interests.

ORIGIN & DEVELOPMENT:

The Station has been in contact with Subject since early 62, when [] met him thru Frau Ilse LEITENBERGER, a former student of one of []' Hamburg contacts, [] ([] wrote [] in late 61 suggesting [] contact LEITENBERGER. LEITENBERGER, an associate editor of Subject's, introduced [] to Subject in April-June 62.) Subject was introduced to his current Station contact, [], by [] circa Jun 65 before [] returned PCS to Hqs. [] has also met Subject. Details of that meeting are not in the record.

Subject is the Station's principal GRANGE contact and his major WOLIME activity on our behalf in the recent past has been surfacing of certain FJSTEAL activities in Austria. More recently, he has been trying to arrange for the travel of one of his associates on behalf of the BGBERET program. Generally, he follows a completely pro-U.S. editorial policy and both he and his principal writers spontaneously support U.S. positions. His ability to accept guidances is limited by the nature of his publication (independent and somewhat conservative) and by the responsible position which it enjoys locally. It is usually not possible to place spot WOLIME items with him.

FREQUENCY OF CONTACT: Once every 4 to 6 wks.

Damage Potential: Subject first met [] as a member of LNCOLD; however, as a result of insinuations made to LEITENBERGER by [] Subject assumed [] to have intelligence duties. [] assumed that [] (a witting collaborator) indicated or implied to LEITENBERGER what [] previous position was in Hamburg, and assuming that he still had intell duties, passed this information along to Subject. Subject subsequently mentioned to [] that he had met with the "chief of intelligence" in GREANAL.
