IMPLICATED WOULD ASSUME POWER, THE ARTICLE STATES. IT WAS INDICATED ALSO THAT THE SITUATION COULD LEAD TO A DETERIORATION OF ECUADORIAN-SOVIET RELATIONS WHICH WERE ESTABLISHED ON THE 10TH OF JUNE OF LAST YEAR. THE DAILY STATES THAT THE SOVIET UNION MAINTAINS IN QUITO A NUMBER OF DIPLOMATIC PERSONNEL WHO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF ECUADOR WHICH "IS URGING THE STRIKE CALLED BY THE CTE" FOR AN AS YET UNDETERMINED DATE IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

B. AFP BROADCAST FROM PARIS 7 JULY DATE LINED QUITO 6 JULY REPORTS GOE "EXPELLED TWO OFFICIALS OF THE SOVIET EMBASSY IN THIS CITY AND WILL PREVENT A THIRD FROM RETURNING TO THE COUNTRY...IT WAS LEARNED THAT THE THREE...WERE DEFINITELY INTERVENING IN PREPARATIONS FOR A PLANNED NATIONAL WORKERS' STRIKE."
