According to CARETINA, John SIEG, born in the U.S. has contacts and relatives who should be investigated. Frankfort files indicate that John SIEG, aka Johannes SIEG, member of the Rote Kapelle, was born in the U.S. of German parents. He returned to Germany in 1912 and later visited the U.S. Until 1933 he was Editor or Assistant Editor on the Rote Fahne. He was a member of the HARNACK group (of Rote Kapelle) from 1940-1942, when, presumably, he was arrested. He was a close friend of SCHULZE-BOYSEN, and after the roundup of arrests in the SCHULZE-BOYSEN complex, is reported to have committed suicide by prison jump. EGQA-81163, 17 August 1956.
