SUBJECT: (U) MARTIN SCHUNACK (DOB: 8 October 1912, Terpersdorf, Germany)

TO: DAD, Germany

1. (c) On 27 May 63 a usually reliable source of OSI, noting that SUBJECT, who is the Deputy Chief of the Uniformed Police in Wiesbaden, was interested in and probably would be further officially involved in President Kennedy's visit to Wiesbaden in June 63, furnished the following information to OSI:

a. SUBJECT is a Kriminalhauptkommissar of the Schutzpolizei, Wiesbaden. He resides at #3 Dantestrasse; his telephone number is 27 11 9. He resides at that address with his wife HELGA who was born 26 September 1920 in Wiesbaden. He formerly drove a vehicle, a Hansa 1000, yellow in color, with Wiesbaden license WI-MS-40. It is not known if he still has this vehicle.

b. In the Spring of 1960 the LfV, Hesse, was advised by one HEINRICH PAPRITZ (DPOB: 10 February 1932, Koenigsberg, East Prussia) a refugee and suspected MPS agent, that he recognized SCHUNACK as an ex-SS official and he could not understand how SCHUNACK could hold his present official position. Based on this, the LfV checked the Berlin Document Center and determined that SCHUNACK had been a Hauptsturmfuhrer.

c. At about the same time (Spring 1960) a source of the LfV who lives near SCHUNACK reported that he had seen suspicious activities at the SCHUNACK residence on evenings. These activities consisted of the transfer of packages from SCHUNACK's car to the cars of visitors. Based on this, during the late Summer and Fall of 1960 the LfV conducted surveillances on SCHUNACK's residence. These surveillances disclosed that SCHUNACK would come home late at night and transfer packages from his car to the vehicle of a visitor or, in addition, he would have visitors at night and he would bring packages from his house which were loaded into the visitor's car. The contents of the packages and the nature of SCHUNACK's activities were not determined by the LfV. The visitors at SCHUNACK's residence were identified by the license numbers of their cars but no unfavorable information was disclosed during file checks on these persons. The LfV dropped the case due to the lack of a specific allegation and because SCHUNACK is a high official in the Wiesbaden police, with which organization the LfV does not have a close amicable relationship.


d. OSI's source stated that based on the above he makes the surmise that SCHUNACK may be under pressure from a hostile intelligence service who may know of his former SS position. This source further advised that he believed it would be appropriate if OSI were to initiate CIS coverage on SUBJECT's mail and telephone.

2. (C) On 29 May 63 a review of the files of the USAREUR Central Registry did not disclose any information on SUBJECT. On 29 May 63 a review of the files of the 7000th Support Wing, CAS, Germany, and the Technical Research Btn of the 513th Intelligence Corps Group were reviewed and did not disclose any information on SUBJECT. The files of OSI District 70 do not contain any information on SUBJECT or wife.

3. (U) OSI is awaiting a Berlin Document Center check on SUBJECT and further hopes to obtain biographical data on SUBJECT based on our request for such data on all leading police officials in Wiesbaden.

4. (U) This correspondence is classified CONFIDENTIAL to protect the source of OSI's information on SUBJECT.
